Generally, an appropriate tip would be \$4-\$6 USD per person for a half day tour and \$10-\$15 USD per person for a full day tour.

Currency:

For your convenience, currency exchange rates are updated periodically so you can calculate pricing. The purchase of an excursion is charged in the same currency you paid for your cruise. Online cancellations will be returned to the credit card used and onboard refunds will be returned to your SeaPass® account in USD.

Price Changes:

Prices can change at any time and can vary by sail date and cruise. The prices in this brochure are valid for the sail date and cruise at the time the brochure was created an are subject to availability. Delays and changes to tour itineraries:

In case of a delayed arrival into a port, announcements will be made regarding the exiting of the vessel and tour departure times.
