Thrill to the cobalt-blue beauty of Grand Etang Crater Lake, high above sea level, and the fern-ridged road to Annandale Falls, where a steep walk leads to a paradise of greenery and rushing waterfalls.

Enjoy an extraordinary exploration through Aruba, showcasing the historical and natural landmarks that make this island so unique. This tour is provided by an operator that has been third-party certified to meet the Global Sustainable Tourism Council's Criteria for Tour Operators.

Highlights:

- › Set out on a scenic drive through Oranjestad, starting at Linear Park, the longest park in the Caribbean, with a smooth, paved, 10-mile trail that extends from the airport, and along the sea, to downtown Oranjestad. It's ideal for walking, jogging, biking, and sightseeing; plus there are plenty of rest stops and refreshment options along the way.
- › Snap a photo at Lourdes Grotto, a unique Roman Catholic shrine built into the rocks in Seroe Pretoe (black hill). In 1958, a 700-kilogram statue of the Virgin Mary was placed in the grotto. Since then, a mass is performed here every year on the feast day of the Lady of Lourdes.
- › Continue towards Arikok National Park, a spectacular national park that covers almost 20% of the island. Here, explore Fontein Cave, the most popular of the limestone caves, which boasts pictographs on the walls and ceilings left behind by the Caquetios, and graffiti imprinted by early European settlers. Then visit Quadirikiri Cave, famous for its two chambers. It's illuminated by bright sunlight, which streams through the holes in the cave's roof, making flashlights redundant. Meanwhile, the darker areas of the cave offer the perfect resting place for nocturnal bats.
- › Journey along Frenchman's Pass, a narrow passageway, between coral cliffs and above the Spanish Lagoon. Its name derives from an old Aruban legend that tells the tale of 17th-century French pirates who attempted to invade Aruba but were confronted by Indians in this narrow passage. The defeated Indians hid in caves where they died from smoke inhalation when the pirates tried to smoke them out. Nearby inhabitants claim they hear crying noises from the Indians to this day.
- › Arrive at Casibari Rock Formation, one of Aruba's most famous natural wonders, where you'll have the opportunity to wander among the cluster of quartz diorite boulders that mysteriously rise out of the desert landscape in peculiar forms, some resembling birds and dragons. There are

several groomed walking trails and it's worth taking the stairway hike to the top of the hill for breathtaking views of the island.
